Ratepayers may choose to pay their rate account by instalments subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The rate discount for payment within thirty (30) or sixty (60) days is forfeited and becomes payable;
- (2) The application must be in writing, by signing this form below AND returning to Council no later than the due date listed on the front of the Rate Notice.
- Ratepayers are encouraged to return forms as soon as possible to avail themselves of the longest payment period possible;**
- (3) Instalments will be calculated including the annual water and sewerage access levies (if applicable), but not the half yearly water consumption charge that appears on the February/March Utility notice;
- (4) The instalment amount is determined by taking the GROSS amount outstanding (including the February water & sewerage access component) and dividing by the number of monthly, fortnightly or weekly payments required to finalise the arrangement by 30 June of the rating year;
- (5) Council prefers that all rates and charges are fully paid by 30 June each year to avoid arrears showing on the subsequent rate notice;
- (6) Monthly Instalments are due on the 21<sup>st</sup> of each month; Payment on an alternate date can be approved upon application;
- (7) Payment via Direct debit (where the ratepayer authorises Council to debit their nominated account or credit card) is only an option for monthly instalments on the 21<sup>st</sup> of the month;
- (8) Weekly or Fortnightly instalments cannot be paid by direct debit and must be paid by an alternate method as per the agreed schedule;
- (9) Ratepayers will be advised in writing when their FIRST instalment payment is due but should not wait for confirmation before making payments;
- (10) Council will not forward reminder notices for instalments;
- (11) The February water consumption amount must be paid separately to any instalment plan;
- (12) Failure to pay the February Water Consumption amount by the due date on that Notice, will result in interest charges applying to the total debt;
- (13) There is no interest penalty if the above conditions are met;
- (14) Interest will apply if the instalment application is submitted AFTER the due date listed on Rate Notice (usually the second discount date);**
- (15) Default of ANY payment, via ANY method will result in commencement of the interest penalty, calculated at 11% per annum, compounded on daily balances.**
