TEMPORARY LOAD LIMIT GOONDOON STREET

Council advises that the section of Goondoon Street extending from Tank Street to Herbert Street, Gladstone, will temporarily close to vehicles heavier than five tonnes from Monday, September 3. The load limit will be implemented to enable Council to investigate the cause of several substructure anomalies that have been identified at the location. The introduction of a load limit is a precautionary measure only to ensure the safety of drivers and passengers of heavy vehicles. Traffic advising measures will be in place throughout the works to ensure vehicles weighing more than five tonnes do not access the area.
