Must do Activities	<p>Paperbark Walking Trail – The Paperbark trail walk is an easy 15-minute loop opposite the entry to Springs Beach, Agnes Water. The Paperbark Trail has stepping stones, a wooden boardwalk and is home to some of the most spectacular Paperbark trees and many creeping vines, butterflies and many amazing wonders.</p>  <p>LARC! Tours – Experience the LARC – an amphibiously along secluded sandy beaches and pristine waterways of the Town of 1770, the Birthplace of Queensland.</p> <p>1770 Headland & Lookout – This trail starts from the parking area at 1770 Headlands and goes to and from the lookouts, approximately 15 minute and is any easy walk.
