Work set to start on Bray Park upgrade

Gladstone Region skating enthusiasts can look forward to enjoying an upgraded facility at Boyne Island's Bray Park for the Christmas school holidays.

Work on the project starts on Monday, September 24 when contractors arrive on site to begin the demolition phase.

Gladstone Region Mayor Matt Burnett said the skate park upgrade's expected completion date was late November, weather permitting.

"Our plan is to reopen the skate park for the summer holidays so skaters can enjoy the new facility and then begin work on the pump track as kids head back to school in late January 2019.

"Construction of the pump track should take about four weeks, weather permitting," Councillor Burnett said.
