1.0 Introduction

Following the Council Resolution on 22 January 2019, the Project Manager, Council's Community Engagement Specialist and Communications & Public Relations Specialist prepared the Community Engagement Plan and the Communications Strategy.

The Community Engagement Plan identified the objectives, level of impact, level of engagement, stakeholders and engagement method over three identified phases (ie. Pre-Engagement, Engagement and Post-Engagement).

The Communications Strategy expanded on the Community Engagement Plan and outlined the communication objectives, how, who to and when communications would be delivered and the consistent key messages to be delivered over the engagement period.

The Community Engagement was undertaken from Monday 25 February 2019 to Friday 8 March 2019.

2.0 Community Engagement Background

2.1 Objectives

Objective 1

To seek the community's views on a proposed Aquatic Recreation Centre in the Boyne Tannum area.

Objective 2

To gather feedback on the three shortlisted sites from the Feasibility Study.

Objective 3

To find out which components the community would value most in an Aquatic facility.

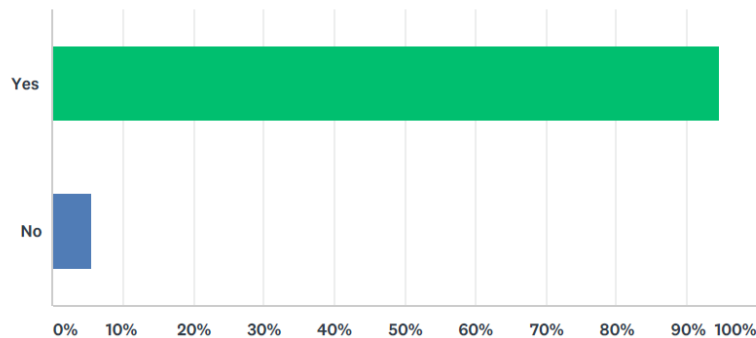

6.0 Key Findings

General

The results of the community engagement show that of the 1422 responders, 94.61% would like a new facility. Of the responders, 80.38% (1143) were from the Boyne Tannum region.

The 2016 census data for the Boyne Island and Tannum Sands area shows the population of the Boyne/Tannum area as:

The number of responders from Boyne Island total 430 or 9.03% of the population. The number of responders from Tannum Sands total 713 or 13.8% of the population.

Sites

The Survey results (total score) indicate the preferred location for a facility as (listed in preference order):

- Coronation Drive, Tannum Sands
- 3 Hampton Drive, Tannum Sands
- 10 Canoe Point Road, Tannum Sands

188 Boyne Island residents and 178 Tannum Sands residents listed Hampton Drive as Preference No. 1

110 Boyne Island residents and 357 Tannum Sands residents listed Coronation Drive as Preference No. 1.

130 Boyne Island residents and 206 Tannum Sands residents listed Canoe Point Road as Preference No. 1.

From these results, it appears that the majority of Boyne Island responders prefer Hampton Drive, while the majority of Tannum Sands responders prefer Coronation Drive.

Eleven (11) other sites were suggested as suitable for a facility.

Components

The Survey results (total score) indicate the preferred components the community would like to see in a facility as (listed in preference order):

- 50m Pool
- Kids Splash Zone
- Waterslide
- 25m Pool
- Hydrotherapy
- BBQ facilities

- Café
- Swim Meet Club
- Gym/Sauna/Spa

However, when looking at the 1st preference selection only, the preferred components the community would like to see in a facility is slightly different (listed in order):

- 50m Pool
- Waterslide
- 25m Pool
- Kids Splash Zone
- Hydrotherapy
- Swim Meet Club and Gym/Sauna/Spa
- Café
- BBQ facilities

In both scenarios, the top 4 remain the same, ie. 50m Pool, Waterslide, 25m Pool and Kids Splash Zone, with the 50m Pool being the highest preferred component.

The hard copy surveys (HC) which did not highlight a preference order and the attendees at the Community Consultation (CC), also showed a 50m pool as the preferred component. However, the 2nd preference altered between Kids Splash Zone (HC) vs Hydrotherapy (CC) and Café (HC) vs Kids Splash Zone (CC) as the 3rd preference.

Rates

Of the 1,388 responders who answered this question, 658 or 47.41% would not justify a rate increase, whereas 498 or 35.88% would.

Entrance Fee

Of the 1,382 responders who answered this question, 1,284 or 92.91% would consider paying an entrance fee, whereas 98 or 7.09% would not.

Of the responders who would consider paying an entrance fee, 53.3% were from Tannum Sands and 31.5% were from Boyne Island.

The expectation of the entrance fee is \$2.50 with 44.11% of responders marking this choice. The next highest choice being \$5.00 with 30.54% selecting this.

7.0 Conclusion

That based solely on the survey responses, the community would like to see the development of an Aquatic Recreation Centre in Boyne Island/Tannum Sands on the Coronation Drive site, consisting of at least a 50m pool (being the highest preference), Kids Splash Zone, Waterslide and 25m pool. It is the community's opinion that the facility does not justify a rate increase and an entrance fee of \$2.50 should apply.
