### Part 1 Preliminary

#### 1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Keeping of Animals (Amendment)* Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2017.

#### 2 Subordinate local law amended

This subordinate local law amends Subordinate Local Law No. 1.5 (Keeping of Animals) 2011.

### Part 2 Amendments to subordinate local law

#### 3 Amendment of sch 1 (Keeping of animals)

(1) Schedule 1, after section 3(7) —

insert —

- (8) If the application of a person is for a cat breeder approval—the documents and materials that must accompany the application also include the following—
  - (a) the person's name; and
  - (b) the address of
    - (i) if the person is an individual the person's place of residence; or
    - (ii) if the person is a body corporate the body corporate's place of business, head office or registered office; and
  - (c) the person's telephone number; and
  - (d) the person's email address; and
  - (e) whether the person is a child; and
  - (f) details of whether the person is subject to—
    - (i) a prohibition order or an interim prohibition order made under the *Animal Care and Protection Act 2001*; or
    - (ii) an order made under a law of another State or the Commonwealth having the same, or substantially the same, effect as an order mentioned in subparagraph (i); and
  - (g) details of whether a cat breeder approval of the person has been cancelled under *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011* in the last 5 years; and
  - (h) details of whether a cat breeder approval of the person under a corresponding law, to breed cats has been cancelled in the last 5 years.'.
- (2) Schedule 1, after section 4(14) —

- (15) If the application of a person is for a cat breeder approval whether the person is an ineligible person.
- (16) For subsection (15), a person is an *ineligible person* if—
  - (a) the person is a child; or
  - (b) the person is subject to—
    - (i) a prohibition order or an interim prohibition order made under the *Animal Care and Protection Act 2001*; or
    - (ii) an order made under a law of another State or the Commonwealth having the same, or substantially the same, effect as an order mentioned in subparagraph (i); or
  - (c) a cat breeder approval of the person has been cancelled under *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011* in the last 5 years; or
  - (d) a cat breeder approval of the person under a corresponding law, to breed cats has been cancelled in the last 5 years.'.
- (3) Schedule 1, after section 6(3)—

insert-

- <sup>(4)</sup> The conditions that will ordinarily be imposed on an approval to keep 1 or more cats on premises under a cat breeder approval are the minimum standards prescribed in *Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011*, schedule 5, item 8.'.
- (4) Schedule 1, after section 7(2)—

insert-

(3) The term of a cat breeder approval for the keeping of a cat may be limited to the life of the cat.'.

#### 4 Amendment of sch 3 (Dictionary)

Schedule 3—

insert-

*cat breeder approval* has the meaning given in *Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011*, section 4(3).

corresponding law has the meaning given in the authorising local law.

ineligible person has the meaning given in schedule 1, section 4(16).'.
