Commencement

2. This notice commences on the date it is published in the gazette.

Making of subordinate local law

3. Gladstone Regional Council (the "Council") has, by resolution dated the 4th day of September 2012, made *Parking (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2012*.

Local law that authorises the subordinate local law to be made

4. *Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2011* authorises the making of *Parking (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2012*.

Subordinate local law amended

5. *Parking (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2012* amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2011*.

Purpose and general effect

6. The purpose and general effect of *Parking (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2012* is to identify off-street regulated parking areas in the local government area of Council so that parking on the areas may be regulated under the local law.

Consolidated version of subordinate local law

7. Council has, by resolution dated the 4th day of September 2012, adopted a consolidated version of *Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2011*.

Inspection

8. Copies of *Parking (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2012* and the consolidated version of *Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2011* may be—
