Queensland Chamber Orchestra to perform at two Council venues

Gladstone Region residents will be able to enjoy stunning musical performances with Camerata, Queensland's Chamber Orchestra, primed and ready to visit Gladstone later this month.

Gladstone Region Acting Mayor Chris Trevor said residents would have two opportunities to see the acclaimed Camerata perform at Council venues.

Camerata will present a concert at Gladstone Entertainment Convention Centre (GECC) on Wednesday, 26 June incorporating new Australian music and great classical music heroes.
