Extension of Parliamentary Privilege to Local Government

The LGAQ's Annual Conference Motions Committee review all motions against the criteria for inclusion in the agenda. The committee found that while the motion itself is valid, we would strongly advise council to proceed with caution and recommend that this motion is withdrawn. At a time when local government is seeking to demonstrate its commitment to transparency and accountability, it is recommended that this does not support this message.

I would like to stress that this does not reflect a lack of concern for/or appreciation of the issue that is raised, or the challenge placed on individuals in executing their elected member responsibilities and the contrast that exists with State parliamentarians.
