Proof of identity may include:

- Driver's licence
- ID card
- Student card

Proof of residency may include:

- Government document (Centrelink, electoral roll card etc.)
- Rental lease/receipt or rates notice
- Bank statement
- Employer letter or pay advice

Children need a parent or guardian to apply for membership on their behalf. The parent/guardian must produce proof of identity and residency, as above.

Respect For Others

The library is your place — a space for study or relaxation or meeting your friends.

You are asked to respect other people by keeping noise to a minimum. People who continually disrupt other library users will be asked to leave.

We encourage children to be frequent visitors to our libraries. However, appropriate behaviour is important and those under 12 must have adult supervision at all times.

Membership Card & Responsibilities

Your membership card is non-transferable and must be presented for borrowing, placing holds on items and accessing other library services as required. You should notify the library of:

- Any lost or damage items or membership cards;
- Change of address or contact details.

Borrowing Items

Each member can borrow a maximum of 20 items for a loan period of 3 weeks.

eLibrary items are not included in the borrowing rules above (limits are applied by each provider).

Returning Items

Items can be returned to any of the six libraries in the Gladstone Region, regardless of where you borrowed them.

Each library has an after hours return chute.

Renewing Items

Items can be renewed up to 3 times as long as they are not overdue or reserved for someone else. Renew online, by phone, or at one of our libraries.

Overdue Items

We do not have overdue fines but your membership card will be blocked until all overdue items are returned; three blocks within a year will result in a three-month suspension.

Overdue notices are sent as a courtesy by mail or email. Membership card blocks and suspensions still apply if a notice was not received.

Replacement or repair costs apply for lost or damaged items.
