

## ***Local Government Act 2009***

1. Gladstone Regional Council ("Council") has proposed to make Animal Management (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019.
2. Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011 authorises the making of Animal Management (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019.
3. Animal Management (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 amends Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011.
4. The purpose and general effect of Animal Management (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 is to —
  - (a) prescribe animals that may be disposed of without auction or tender; and
  - (b) prohibit the keeping of prescribed animals; and
  - (c) require an approval in respect of the keeping of prescribed animals; and
  - (d) prescribe minimum standards for the keeping of animals; and
  - (e) prohibit animals in public places in specified circumstances; and
  - (f) identify dog off leash areas.
5. Written submissions by any person in support of, or objecting to, the proposed subordinate local law referred to in paragraph 1 are invited for a 28 day period commencing on Saturday 23 November 2019 and ending on Friday 20 December 2019 (the "consultation period").
6. During the consultation period Council will make available for inspection and purchase at Council's public office at 101 Goondoon Street Gladstone copies of the proposed subordinate local law referred to in paragraph 1.
7. Submissions must be received on or before Friday 20 December 2019 stating—
  - (a) the grounds of the submission; and
  - (b) the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds.
