- Develop incentive programs for stakeholders to encourage weed and pest animal controls.
- Encourage and facilitate the development and implementation of pest management plans.

- Provide effective input into Commonwealth and State Government initiatives and polices to reduce impact and improve the management of weeds and pest animals.
- Facilitate the integration of pest management into natural resource management processes.
- Advocacy role for stakeholders in pest management issues.

CMPG actively engage and work with Local Government authorities within the Region, Queensland Government agencies, Department of Agriculture and Fisheries, Gladstone Area Water Board, Landcare, Fitzroy Basin Association, industry and primary producer groups to explore opportunities to collaborate on regional projects to promote pest management techniques and coordinate shared training.



We are funded by annual memberships and by special project funding.

We utilise the resources and strategies of the Weeds of National Significance program and work in parallel and compliance with the *Biosecurity Act* 2014.

Our vision is to be regarded as the foremost authority on pest management in Central Queensland, addressing pest management priorities and establishing innovative strategies and protocols for regional pest management.
