

**Local Government Act 2009
(Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 1) 2020**

Title

1. This notice may be cited as *Gladstone Regional Council (Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 1) 2020*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences on 1 July 2020.

Making of subordinate local law

3. Gladstone Regional Council (the "Council") has, by resolution dated the 21st day of January 2020, made subordinate local laws as follows—
 - (a) *Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (b) *Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (c) *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (d) *Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*.

Subordinate local law amended

4. The subordinate local laws referred to in paragraph 3 amend existing subordinate local laws of Council as follows—
 - (a) *Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.1 (Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2011*; and
 - (b) *Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.15 (Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation) 2011*; and
 - (c) *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011*.

Subordinate local law repealed

5. *Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* repeals *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.16 (Gates and Grids) 2011*.

Local law that authorises a subordinate local law to be made

6. Local laws of Council authorise the making of the subordinate local laws referred to in paragraph 3 as follows—
 - (a) *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011* authorises the making of—
 - (i) *Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (ii) *Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (iii) *Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*; and
 - (b) *Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011* authorises the making of *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020*.

Purpose and general effect

7. The purpose and general effect of the subordinate local laws referred to in paragraph 3 is as follows—
 - (a) the purpose and general effect of *Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* is to repeal *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.16 (Gates and Grids) 2011*; and
 - (b) the purpose and general effect of *Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* is, to the extent that the subordinate local law prescribes criteria which must be complied with before an approval will be granted, to prescribe that an approval will not be granted if the alteration or improvement includes the installation of a gate or grid across a road, or the repair or replacement of a gate or grid installed across a road; and
 - (c) the purpose and general effect of *Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* is, to the extent that the subordinate local law prescribes criteria which must be complied with before an approval will be granted, to prescribe that an approval will not be granted if the carrying out of the work or interference with the road or its operation includes installing a gate or grid across a road, or the repair or replacement of a gate or grid installed across a road; and
 - (d) the purpose and general effect of *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2020* is to remove the mechanism whereby a person who wishes to install, or is a responsible person for, a gate or a grid across a road may apply for an approval for a restricted activity.

Inspection

8. A copy of each subordinate local law referred to in paragraph 3 may be—
 - (a) inspected and purchased at Council's public office at 101 Goondoon Street, Gladstone; and
 - (b) viewed by the public on the website of the Department of Local Government.
