'Wet' your appetite for water by participating in Council survey

Gladstone Regional Council is encouraging residents to participate in the *What is water to you?* survey to gain a better understanding of how the community uses and values water.

Launching this week and running for three weeks until March 23, the *What is water to you*? survey is designed to help Council understand community appetite for future water conservation measures, regardless of climatic conditions such as drought.

The survey will be hosted on Council's *Conversations* engagement platform with paper copies of the survey also available at a range of Council offices and Rural Transaction Centres (RTC).

Gladstone Region Mayor Matt Burnett said resident participation in the survey will help Council's planning of future water assets.

"Findings from this engagement will contribute to the long-term planning for water asset growth plans and will also help support planning for future projects and water education," Councillor Burnett said.

"Residents can complete the survey online, pick up a copy in person or attend one of three upcoming community engagement sessions."

Cr Burnett said survey results will be shared on the *Conversations* platform and notification emails sent to participants.
