## <u>Cr Trevor</u>

# G/3.1.2. COVID-19 SUPPORT PACKAGE

## Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to provide direction and authority for the granting of financial assistance and support to the local community as a result of Coronavirus (COVID-19).

## Officer's Recommendation:

That pursuant to section 9(1) of the *Local Government Act 2009*, Council resolves that:

- The due date of Water Consumption levies issued by Council in rates notices issued on 18 February 2020, shall be extended under s130(7) of the Local Government Regulation 2012 to have an effective due date of 30 June 2020;
- 2. Effective from 1 March 2020, a concession equivalent to the Interest on Overdue Rates or Charges be granted until 30 June 2020;
- 3. The Chief Executive Officer:
  - (a) report back to Council before 30 June 2020, with recommendations for further rates concessions for the 2020/21 financial year, aligned with the status of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and to take effect from 1 July 2020;
  - (b) update the current Rating Financial Hardship Policy (P-2019-07) to provide concessions for residents, businesses and other entities that have been affected by a pandemic such as the Coronavirus (COVID-19) for approval by Council; and
  - (c) develop and implement a grants program for eligible sporting and community groups that have been adversely affected by Coronavirus (COVID-19). The grants program is to be for a maximum of \$400,000 allocated from the 2019/20 Expenditure Budget with individual grants up to a maximum of \$10,000 for each eligible group;
