Driveways

This checklist helps you manage the steps to obtain an approval to construct or modify a driveway to your property.

1. Check

WHO WILL NEED TO BE INVOLVED?

Who do I need to involve?

Prior to starting this process, it is recommended to seek out an understanding of costs and timing from a Builder as well as a Building Certifier. You may also need a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland (RPEQ).







BUILDER BUILDING CERTIFIER RPEQ ENGINEER

DO I NEED A PERMIT?



If you are building or modifying an existing driveway crossover comply with the standard drawing requirements you will require a permit only.

DO I NEED RPEQ ENGINEER APPROVAL?



If you have a design that is different to Council's standard drawing for driveway. The alternative design is required to be signed off by a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland.

IS MY STREET A STATE CONTROLLED ROAD?



To check if property is located on a state controlled road please visit the Queensland Government's Development Assessment Mapping System (link to website https://dams.dsdip.esriaustraliaonline.com.au/damappingsystem/) and search for your property's address using the search bar. Once you have located your property, go to the left side bar and select SARA DA Mapping > State transport > State transport corridor > State controlled road. This will identify any State Controlled Roads adjacent to your site.

Applications can be submitted and paid for using <u>Council's Online Development Application Portal</u>

4. Start
