Gladstone Region Mayor Matt Burnett said the successful social enterprise mobile food vendor must align with the values of the Philip Street Communities and Families Precinct.

"The Philip Street Communities and Families Precinct has been designed to strengthen Gladstone's community and social service system by the clustering of community facilities to improve and enhance service delivery and community outcomes," Councillor Burnett said.

"Council is looking for a business that exists to benefit the public and community, who are led by an economic, social, cultural or environmental mission and who can provide training and skills development.

"If you think your mobile food service fits that description and can also meet the related terms and conditions, then you are encouraged to submit an EOI for this unique opportunity."

The successful proponent will also be asked to submit an Application to Undertake Commercial Activities on Council land, undergo the standard assessment process by Council's Environmental Health team and comply with Terms and Conditions.
