"Other free but ticketed events include *Flying Drone Workshop: Search and Rescue* held at 10.15am, 11.30am and 1.15pm, and *Future of Sport Workshop* to be held at 10.30am, 12.30pm and 2pm.

"Non-ticketed presentations include the Big Bang Science Show at 10am, 11am, 1pm and 2pm, as well as the Queensland Museum Pop Up Talks at 10.45am, 12.45pm and 1.45pm.
