Gladstone Regional Council will once again host its free Australia Day Family Fun Day at the picturesque surrounds of the Millennium Esplanade parklands at Tannum Sands.

"Our Australia Day Family Fun Day is open to all community members and tickets are not required, however, checking in via the Check in Qld App is still required upon entry."

Cr Burnett also encouraged residents who cannot attend the Tannum Sands event to head along to other Australia Day events taking place across the region.

"Council is supporting several Australia Day events through our Community Investment Program including celebrations at Builyan, Turkey Beach and Ubobo," he said.

"All of these Council-supported events have their own unique characteristics that help celebrate all things Australiana."
