Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* that on 13 July 2022 Cairns Regional Council resolved to:

- Adopt the CairnsPlan 2016 Amendment 1 of 2022 – Minor;
- Adopt the Local Government Infrastructure Plan Amendment 1 of 2022 – Administrative;
- Adopt CairnsPlan 2016 Version 3.1 (incorporating the CairnsPlan 2016 Amendment 1 of 2022 – Minor and Local Government Infrastructure Plan Amendment 1 of 2022 – Administrative).

The purpose and general effect of the CairnsPlan 2016 Amendment 1 of 2022 – Minor is to integrate the Cairns South State Development Area into the planning scheme.

The purpose and general effect of the Local Government Infrastructure Plan Amendment 1 of 2022 – Administrative is to clarify that the Local Government Infrastructure Plan does not consider the Cairns South State Development Area.

The CairnsPlan 2016 Amendment 1 of 2022 – Minor, Local Government Infrastructure Plan Amendment 1 of 2022 – Administrative and CairnsPlan 2016 Version 3.1 stated above commence on 2 August 2022.
