

AMENDMENTS TO ANIMAL MANAGEMENT LOCAL LAW AND SUBORDINATE LOCAL LAW

1. Gladstone Regional Council ("Council") has proposed to make each of:-

(a) Animal Management (Amendment) Local Law (No. 1) 2023 (the "amending local law"); and (b) Animal Management (Amendment)

Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2023 (the "amending subordinate local law").

2. Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management)
