

## Attachment 4 Proposed Options

## **OPTION 1**

Council takes ownership of the existing grids and any future girds, with the costs (ie. insurance, grid repair and maintenance, road approach maintenance, signage) and renewals (replacement of grid at the end of its useful life) met by:

- 1a) The wider rating base
- 1b) Special Levy to landowners

Please note, that under this option, those wanting to add a new grid to the network (completely new location) are to fund the initial installation cost.

## **OPTION 2**

Council takes ownership of all existing grids with the cost of maintenance (ie. insurance, grid repair and maintenance, road approach maintenance, signage) with landowners continuing to be responsible for the initial installation of a new grid and replacement of structures at the end of its useful life.

The cost of insurance and maintenance to be met by:

- 2a) The wider rating base
- 2b) Special Levy to landowners

## **OPTION 3**

Maintain the current policy position, with minor amendment to address dual ownership of grids where required.
