Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's endorsement of Projects for the 2016-17 Works for Queensland Program.

Officer's Recommendation:

 That Council endorse the following projects for submission to the Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning for the \$6,000,000 allocated to Gladstone Regional Council under the 2016-17 Works for Queensland funding program:-

Project Title	Project Description	Total Cost
Lions Park - A Sensory Haven for People of all Abilities	The project is a redevelopment of existing passive parkland adjacent to a major retail precinct. An Australian first, Leonardo da Vinci inspired design, incorporating 24 hour activated play area integrating sensory features accommodating children and adults with disabilities including (but not limited to): sensory processing disorder, auditory processing disorder, visual impairment, down-syndrome, autism, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, and spina bifida.	\$3,318,716 (Excluding GST)
Tom Jeffery Park – A Contemporary Beachside Recreational Area	Redevelopment of parkland which forms the entrance to the Agnes Water main beach commensurate with the importance of the area to the tourism industry of the region. A new ablution facility capable of coping with future demand; Surf Life Saving Queensland first aid room and storage; upgrade of playground; landscaping; carpark; seating; shelters and; BBQs are incorporated in the project.	\$981,000 (Excluding GST)
Mount Larcom – Community Recreation Hub	The project aims to enhance and develop an existing youth/sport/community recreation precinct through the development of new facilities: children's play park; outdoor exercise equipment; outdoor furniture and; community garden.	\$210,000 (Excluding GST)
Accelerated Gravel Program	Sealing dirt roads to reduce maintenance costs, improve air quality for nearby residents, and increase road safety.	\$1,490,284
