

Register of Interests – New or Update

Councillors, councillor advisors, CEOs and senior executive employees and their related persons

❖ Use this form if you:

- are newly elected or appointed, or
- are starting a new term, or
- have already submitted a register of interests and need to register, update, or add new information about an interest.

Once you have completed this form for the first time, ensure you keep an electronic copy for future updates.

This form does not provide for the annual confirmation of your or your related persons interests. Instead, use the Annual Confirmation form to confirm that your register is up to date.

❖ What this form is for

- register your interests and the interests of your related persons when beginning a term or appointment, or
- to update, amend, or change details previously recorded in your or your related persons register of interests.

❖ When to submit it

For all persons required to submit a register of interest:

- complete and submit this form for you and your related persons:
 - within 30 calendar days of starting your term or appointment
 - within 30 calendar days of becoming aware of a change to an existing interest.

Additional requirements for councillors and councillor advisors:

- within 30 days after the end of each financial year if you or your related persons have acquired an interest that is not listed on your register of interest and must be recorded.
- within 30 days after the end of each financial year if there has been a change to the particulars required to be included in the register of interest for you or a related person

❖ How to complete and submit this form

- complete only the sections that apply to you
- write NIL where you have no interests to declare
- complete a form for yourself and a separate form for each related person
- you must sign and initial each page
- submit the completed form to the chief executive officer
- If you are the chief executive officer, submit the completed form to the mayor.

❖ What to do if you are unsure

- for detailed guidance and examples, refer to the Register of Interest Guidance Notes.
- if you are unsure of your legal obligations, speak with your chief executive officer or you may wish to seek independent legal advice.

NOTE: This form does not provide for your required Register of Interests annual confirmation for you or a person related to you. Instead use the Register of Interest - Annual Confirmation Form to ensure that your register, and the registers of persons related to you, are accurate and up to date.

❖ **Related persons definition**

A person is **related** to a councillor, chief executive officer, councillor advisor or senior executive employee (the **primary party**) if—

1. the person is the primary party's spouse; or
2. the person is totally or substantially dependent on the primary party and
 - a) the person is the primary party's child; or
 - b) the person's affairs are so closely connected with the affairs of the primary party that a benefit derived by the person, or a substantial part of it, could pass to the primary party.

❖ **Reporting term, for a relevant person, means—**

(a) for a councillor or a person who is related to a councillor— the relevant councillor's term of office; or

(b) for the chief executive officer or a person who is related to the chief executive officer—

- (i) the period of the chief executive officer's current contract of employment; and
- (ii) if the chief executive officer held a contract of employment as chief executive officer for a period ending immediately before the start of the current contract—the period of the contract of employment ending immediately before the chief executive officer's current contract started; or

(c) for a councillor advisor or a person who is related to a councillor advisor—

- (i) the period of the councillor advisor's current contract of employment; and
- (ii) if the councillor advisor held a contract of employment as a councillor advisor for a period ending immediately before the start of the current contract—the period of the contract of employment ending immediately before the councillor advisor's current contract started; or

(d) for a senior executive employee or a person who is related to a senior executive employee—

- (i) the period of the senior executive employee's current contract of employment; and
- (ii) if the senior executive employee held a contract of employment as a senior executive employee for a period ending immediately before the start of the current contract—the period of the contract of employment ending immediately before the senior executive employee's current contract started.

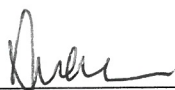
