Purpose:

To allow Baffle Creek Community Inc. to operate a commercial caravan park on their lease area to increase tourism visitation to the area.

Officer's Recommendation:

THAT Baffle Creek Community Inc. be advised that:

- 1. Council does not intend to alter the lease held by Deepwater Horse Sports Inc. without the voluntary consent from that club.
- 2. In any event, Council believes that there is adequate room for Baffle Creek Community Inc. activities on its existing leased area.
- 3. With respect to the housing of RV's and other campers on the leased area, consent is granted under Clause 4 and 4.1 of your lease subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The club being completely responsible for the camping activities, including the actions and omissions of campers.
 - b. Fees may be set by the club on terms and conditions determined by the club from time to time.
 - c. There is to be no on-site disposal of RV sewer waste.
 - d. The club must ensure that other waste is disposed of in order to ensure the efficient collection of bins.
 - e. The arrangement remaining at Council's pleasure, with consent able to be withdrawn with reasonable notice.
 - f. The club meet council minimum standards for operation of a caravan park or seek approval to operate a commercial caravan park.
- 4. Should the scale of RV/camping activities warrant expansion of camping areas into the neighbouring Lease C area, negotiations can be had with that club at that time.

 - b. Satisfaction of all conditions of Part 11 (Alterations) of the Licence Agreement held between Council and Gladstone Rugby League.
 - c. All requisite planning and building approvals being obtained before construction commences.
- 2. Council does not intend making any financial contribution toward the project.
